

Here is a brief description to give you an idea of what each ECA includes:-

Sunday

Drawing Skills - Children will need a good quality A3 sized (double A4) sketch pad which they should bring to the club each week. The children will be given observational drawing tasks to do in their sketch books. They will use different media e.g. pencils, pens and pastels.

Lego Construction – come along and build amazing different things out of lego!

Junk Modelling – children will create fantastic free choice models using household junk and sticky tape

Art Club – Come explore, discover and use imagination with print.

Cricket - Improve your skills in the wonderful game of cricket. Experienced and inexperienced players welcome.

Theatre Design and Prop Making - We will be designing and painting a backdrop and making props for the summer term's production "*Eddie the Penguin Saves the World*".

Netball – Come and learn the rules and have fun playing netball.

Basketball Club – This will be an outside club where we practice the basic skills of the game, from passing , dribbling to shooting, lay ups and to team play.

Ukulele - A ukulele is a small, 4-stringed instrument similar in shape to a guitar. It is a perfect instrument for children to learn as it has nylon strings and a small fretboard. Children who are keen to learn should buy their own instrument where possible (if you are travelling) as they are not available to buy in Doha. I have some ukes available for children to use in class. We will learn to read and play single note melodies, strumming techniques, songs to sing, and how to write your own songs.

Hama Beads - Come and join Miss Jones for fun craft activities. We will be designing and making a variety of items e.g. keyrings, coasters, necklaces, name badges... etc. You need a steady hand and lots of imagination!

Monday

Playball - Playball is a sports activity teaching the basics of 5 different ball sports together with fine and gross motor skills. Playball sports are baseball, tennis, hockey, soccer & basketball. Children get the opportunity to learn the mechanics of each of the 5 sports above in a fun and non-competitive environment and are taught by a trained Playball coach.

Tuesday

Drama - This term in Drama we will be preparing for our school production "*Eddie the Penguin Saves the World*". This involves lots of fun singing, dancing and acting, so come along and join us if you have talent to share and dramatic flair!

Story Activity Club - We will be singing songs, doing making activities and listening to stories to help us develop our English Language skills.

Ballet - Children love music and dancing. This lesson is all about movement, rhythm games, and improvisation. ...a lot of fun! In a playful way your child learns to listen to different styles of music and they learn the basic techniques of ballet. Fun in dancing always comes first!

Free Painting - An opportunity for the children to explore their creativity with paint.

Arabic Cooking – The children will learn more about the Arabic culture famous food in each country and how to make it.

Chess - Chess is a board game for two players who move their 16 pieces according to specific rules; the object is to checkmate the opponent's king.

Ultimate Frisbee - This is a game played with a Frisbee on a grass playing field. The object of the game is for one team to score a point by catching the Frisbee inside their opponent's end zone. There are no referees in this game. The game encourages sportsmanship by people calling their own fouls. At the end of the game the teams sing a song or a poem to each other about the game they just played. One team picks one person on the team who showed the best sportsmanship. The children who sign up for this sport will be taught how to throw a Frisbee, both backhand and forehand. They will learn the rules of the game while they play. They will also be encouraged to sing a quick song or poem as a team to the other team.

Scrabble - Come and play with words and have fun finding new words. You don't need to be a good speller. You do need to be enthusiastic and curious. There are so many exciting words to use, come and explore them in our scrabble club.

Wednesday

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Puzzle Time – Come and join us for a variety of fun puzzles and games.

Lego Construction - come along and build amazing different things out of lego!

Origami - Children will learn the art of paper folding to create simple designs. They will learn the basic folds and techniques in origami. They will produce designs, such as animals, insects and flowers and use these to create collage effects.

Jewelry Designing - Come join us to learn how to make your own necklaces, bracelets, and earrings. You will be making jewelry using techniques in beading, wire work, metal clay, and more. Discover your creative side with jewelry designing!

Sketching Club – We will be sketching a variety of forms, using pencil and pen, and learning how to use shading and perspective.

Kids Yoga - We start with some gentle warm ups, then do various yoga poses, all adapted to young children. If you are particularly good at a pose, you might be asked to come up and demonstrate in front of the class! We do some simple aerobic exercises in between the yoga poses, all aimed at strengthening the body and helping to improve our concentration. We end the class with a ten minute relaxation in the relaxing pose, accompanied by some gentle classical music. Come and join us!

Football - We will be learning passing skills, shooting skills, dribbling skills, str

eam strategy and tactics. We will have fun and enjoy the game.

International Cooking - Have fun cooking (and eating) dishes from different countries and perhaps share your favourite recipe from your home country.
